

Transferred Ownership

Week 1

Theme: Jesus has **authority** because we are no longer our own.

1. Salvation is a change of **ownership**, not merely forgiveness

2. There is a difference between Jesus as **Savior** and Jesus as **Lord**

Core Question: Who actually has the **right** to direct my life?

1. Identifying where we still act as **our own authority**

2. Clarifying the “Great Exchange” of salvation

Practices:

- **Inventory** of life domains (time, money, body, relationships, decisions)

- Prayer of **intentional surrender**

Inventory of Life Domains

In each area, ask:

Who has the "final say" in this? What is the primary goal of this?

Domain 1: The Calendar (Time)

- **The Shift:** From "My time is mine to spend" to "My time is a gift to be invested."
- **The Audit:** Look at your last 7 days. If an outsider looked at your schedule, would they see any "blocked off" time for the Master's business (rest, service, prayer, secret place)?
- **The Practice:** Give God the first of the day (15-30 minutes) and a day of the week (Sabbath).

Domain 2: The Wallet (Money)

- **The Shift:** From "I give God a tip" to "I manage God's wealth."
- **The Audit:** Check your recent transactions. Is there a "line item" for the Kingdom? Lordship in finance isn't just about giving/tithing; it's about asking, "Lord, how do You want me to use the other 90%?"
- **The Practice:** The "Ask Before You Click" rule – praying for 30 seconds before any non-essential purchase.

Domain 3: The Temple (Body & Health)

- **The Shift:** From "My body, my choice" to "Purchased by His blood."
- **The Audit:** How am I fueling and resting the property of God? Am I using my physical senses (eyes, ears, touch) in a way that honors the Owner?
- **The Practice:** A "Digital Fast", work out, or commitment to sleep as an act of trust in God.

Domain 4: The Inner Circle (Relationships)

- **The Shift:** From "People exist to meet my needs" to "People are souls for me to love."
- **The Audit:** Is there anyone I am refusing to forgive? (Unforgiveness is a claim of ownership over a debt that Jesus already settled).
- **The Practice:** The "Empty Chair" prayer – praying for your difficult relationships while acknowledging Jesus as the Lord over that connection.

Domain 5: The Compass (Decisions)

- **The Shift:** From "What makes sense to me?" to "What is obedient to Him?"
- **The Audit:** When faced with a crossroad, do I seek God's Word first, or do I decide and then ask Him to bless it?
- **The Practice:** The "24-Hour Rule" – for any major decision, wait 24 hours to specifically seek scripture and counsel.
