1 - LOOK UPWARD with PRAISE AND THANKSGIVING

- Jesus we kneel, sit, or stand to look upon your face and fall in complete adoration of who You are as the son of Man and the son of God.
- Jesus, how can I give you praise for who you have been to me and for what you have done for me in this moment of prayer?

<u>Philippians 2:1-2</u>: Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness & compassion, then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind.

I will praise you forever, O God, for what you have done. I will trust in your good name in the presence of your faithful people. -Ps 52:9

I will praise you, Lord, with all my heart; I will tell of all the marvelous things you have done. -Ps 9:1

The Lord lives! Praise to my Rock! May the God of my salvation be exalted! -Psalm 18:46

Praise the Lord! For he has heard my cry for mercy. -Psalm 28:6

I will praise the Lord at all times. I will constantly speak his praises. -Psalm 34:1

O my Strength, to you I sing praises, for you, O God, are my refuge, the God who shows me unfailing love. -Psalm 59:17

2 - LOOK INWARD in CONFESSION AND REPENTANCE

◆ Search me- Jesus, where is my heart drawing near to you and wandering from you, closed and opened toward your love? What feelings do I need share with you? What are the desires of my heart?
