PRAY FOR NEW SCHOOL YEAR:

Lord Jesus Christ, as a child, you grew in wisdom and stature, favor with God and people, you listened to your teachers and asked them questions, you where always about your Father's business. May we follow in your footsteps and be like you.

PRAY FOR STUDENTS

Lord Jesus, we pray that You would grant them a hunger to learn new things and patience when the learning gets tough, that You would bring alongside them good friends to building their character, that You would provide for their needs and open doors of opportunity, and that You would keep Your hand of protection over them, keeping them safe from illness, bullying and violence.

GRADE SCHOOL (K-5th):

- Jesus becomes known and real to them personally.
- Discovery of Jesus being known in the public place.
- Have a good attitude and be a positive influence on their friend.
- Choose to follow God's path and make Godly friendships.
- Develop patience and understanding for others.
- Show respect to teachers, leaders and each other.
- Make choices to honor God above all else.
- Bear the Fruit of the Spirit (love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control).
- Have a discerning heart for truth (versus non-truth) in their culture and world.
- Honor their parents and give their best effort for God's glory.
- Safety in all environments and interactions.
- Physical, emotional, mental, financial, relational, and spiritual health.

MIDDLE AND HIGH SCHOOL:

- Desire to honor God and walk consistent, humble and courageous in their faith.
- Make meaningful connections with teachers, coaches and peers.
- Feel heard and supported at school, home, and church.
- Freedom and space to be themselves.
- Be an ambassador of Christ, living and sharing the Gospel.
- Resist temptation and pursue holiness in thoughts, online and sexually.
- Respond well to pressure and hardships with academic work, tests, relationships.
- Safety and protection at school, during athletics, and while driving.
- Navigate the difficult transition of attending a new schools and new classes, changing of faculty and district, from building-to-building and class-to-class.
- Respect their teachers and authority in school while standing for righteousness.
- See the learning as a part of God's plan for their life and become a life-long learner.

COLLEGE STUDENTS:

- Live out their Christian faith in words and actions to those around them.
- Hunger and thirst for more of Jesus capturing their heart and changing their life.
- Desire and discipline to meet with Jesus in the secret place through prayer, silence solitude, sabbath, and scripture.
- Desire and discipline to be more like Jesus in the public place, sharing his life, light and love in our world.
- Love the gift of the local church, it's gatherings and mutual support, accountability, and service with one another amidst the pressures of a typical college student life.
- Love the learning process as part of God's plan for their life and be content with where God has them.
- Give them strong desire draw near to Christ, for grace and power to fight sin and temptation, pursue holiness and live with integrity especially sexually.
- Grow spiritually and emotionally in all their relationships including lifelong friendships and future Godly spouses.
- Learn to live life skillfully according to God's wisdom and design.
- Have the mind of Christ and be full of his grace and truth as they encounter differing world-views and belief systems.
- Desire to give their best for the glory of God (not settling for less than God's best).
- Provide jobs that work well with school, necessary finances, and travel mercies.

PRAY FOR PARENTS

- Provide them an eye and heart for the strugglers.
- Ambassadors of Christ wherever they go and whoever they meet.

PRAY FOR ADMINISTRATORS:

Heavenly Father, we pray for all administrators working in and for our schools as an overseer like you. For superintendents, principals, assistant principals, deans and board members and more...

We pray for wise decision making, for abundant provision for their buildings, spaces, and resources. We pray Holy Spirt for your spiritual discernment and enlightenment in problem solving, We pray, Jesus that your peace, grace and truth will be their constant companions.

Holy Spirit be with them and empower them with divine wisdom, strength, and compassion to lead our respective districts and schools through the upcoming school year.

PRAY FOR SUPPORT STAFF:

For assistants, aides, librarians, coaches, nurses, counselors, psychologists, bus drivers, cafeteria staff, crossing guards, police officers, custodians, office staff, athletic trainers, boosters, paraprofessionals, and more...

- Safety in transportation, competition, and practice for their teams.

PRAY FOR VOLUNTEERS (IN & OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM):

- Have a servant heart, others first attitude, motivated by Christ to serve the community out of love for God and others especially our young people.
- Have creativity and ingenuity as they seek to serve.
- Resist entertaining gossip and turn a deaf ear to politics.
- Awareness of ministry opportunities as they interact with students and faculty (simply be present, listen well, share a smile or a word of kindness).
- Demonstrate a gracious and generous spirit toward others.
- God would honor their sacrifices of personal and family time to serve others.

PRAY FOR HOMESCHOOL FAMILIES:

Parents

- Bear the weight of responsibility to educate their kids with Jesus.
- Balance schedules and needs of each kid.
- Ability to adapt and adjust based on each kids learning needs.
- Inspire, encourage, and build up kids.
- Inspire kids to develop a love of learning.
- Confident in who God created them to be and called them to teach their kids.
- Learn how to not exasperate their children but instead grow in patience and endurance.
- Wisdom for curriculum choices and extracurricular activities.
- Respond wisely and graciously to those who question or their choice to their homeschool.
- Encourage other homeschooling families or those who may have questions.
- Connect and work well with Co-ops (leadership, organizational challenges, building complications).

Kids

- Be a student God's Word and follower of Jesus every day.
