Jesus' Arrival

(palm branch, leaf, pine needles, etc)

Matthew 21:8-9 NLT

Most of the crowd spread their garments on the road ahead of him, and others cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road.

Jesus was in the center of the procession, and the people all around him were shouting,

"Praise God for the Son of David!

Blessings on the one who comes in the name of the Lord!

Praise God in highest heaven!"

Then Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve disciples, went to the leading priests and asked, "How much will you pay me to betray Jesus to you?" And they gave him thirty pieces of silver. From that time on, Judas began looking for an opportunity to betray Jesus.

Jesus Washes Feet

(cloth, towel, rag, tissue, etc)

John 13:3-5 NLT

Jesus knew that the Father had given him authority over everything and that he had come from God and would return to God. So he got up from the table, took off his robe, wrapped a towel around his waist, and poured water into a basin. Then he began to wash the disciples' feet, drying them with the towel he had around him.

The Last Supper

(small cup, toy bread, pretend meal, etc)

Matthew 26:26-28 NLT

As they were eating, Jesus took some bread and blessed it. Then he broke it in pieces and gave it to the disciples, saying, "Take this and eat it, for this is my body."

And he took a cup of wine and gave thanks to God for it. He gave it to them and said, "Each of you drink from it, for this is my blood, which confirms the covenant between God and his people. It is poured out as a sacrifice to forgive the sins of many.

(flower, personal prayer, praying hands, etc)

Matthew 26:39 NLT

He went on a little farther and bowed with his face to the ground, praying, "My Father! If it is possible, let this cup of suffering be taken away from me. Yet I want your will to be done, not mine."

Peter Denies Jesus

(string, rope, handcuffs, etc)

Luke 22:56-57 NLT

Peter joined them there. A servant girl noticed him in the firelight and began staring at him. Finally she said, "This man was one of Jesus' followers!"

But Peter denied it. "Woman," he said, "I don't even know

him!"

Jesus Crucified

(cross, thorns, whip, etc))

Matthew 27:31 NLT

When they were finally tired of mocking him, they took off the robe and put his own clothes on him again. Then they led him away to be crucified.

Veil Is Torn

(clothe with a tear, torn tissue, etc)

Matthew 27:50-51 NLT

Then Jesus shouted out again, and he released his spirit. At that moment the curtain in the sanctuary of the Temple was torn in two, from top to bottom.

Jesus' Body Is Wrapped

(toy wrapped in white clothe, toy wrapped in toilet paper, etc)

Matthew 27:59-60 NLT

Joseph took the body and wrapped it in a long sheet of clean linen cloth. He placed it in his own new tomb, which had been carved out of the rock. Then he rolled a great stone across the entrance and left.

Tomb Is Seal

(rock, stone, picture of tomb, etc)

Matthew 27:65-66 NLT

Pilate replied, "Take guards and secure it the best you can." So they sealed the tomb and posted guards to protect it.

Mary Visits The Tomb

(toy of a girl, broken rock, etc)

John 20:1 NLT

Early on Sunday morning, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and found that the stone had been rolled away from the entrance.

Matthew 28:5-7 NLT

Then the angel spoke to the women. "Don't be afraid!" he said.
"I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He isn't
here! He is risen from the dead, just as he said would happen.
Come, see where his body was lying. And now, go quickly and
tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and he is going
ahead of you to Galilee. You will see him there. Remember what I
have told you."
